Duane Michals has received numerous awards and grants throughout his career—notably the NEA Fellowship and the Foto Espana International Award. His photographs have been shown in exhibitions around the world, and are in many private collections and museums, including the Museum of Photographic Arts (MOPA) in Balboa Park, the J. Paul Getty Museum, the Metropolitan Museum of Art and the Israel Museum.
